Overview

The Pathway Bursary Program is designed to award select students enrolled in a qualifying program with Canadore College's Aviation Campus in North Bay, ON. Candidates must have graduated from a Nipissing/Parry Sound District secondary school. The Pathway Bursary Program maintains a continuous enrollment of six (6) awarded students, with preference to Indigenous applicants.

Voyageur's Pathway Bursary Program offers:

- Full tuition scholarship
- Summer employment for those in a two-year program
- Guaranteed offer of full-time employment upon completion of their program

Application Process

Interested candidates are to apply direct to Voyageur's recruitment team at recruitment@voyav.com with the following: high school transcript, resume, letter of recommendation, and letter of acceptance into one (1) of the following programs with Canadore:

- Avionics Technician – Aircraft Maintenance 2 year
- Aviation Technician – Avionics Maintenance 2 year
- Aircraft Structural Repair Technician 1 year

Selection Criteria

Applicants will complete a series of short answers and an interview. The successful applicants will be selected based on the following criteria:

- Short answer responses
- Interview
- Letter of recommendation
- For Indigenous hiring, the student must provide proof of status
